Gentlemen:

Cities Service Oil Company respectfully requests permission to drill the No. 1 Elizondo-Federal "A" on oil and gas lease New Mexico 0354232, located 660' FNL, 1980' FWL, Section 28-21S-27E, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico.

In support of this application the following data is submitted:

1. Form 9-331C, Application for Permit to Drill
2. Form C-102, Well Location and Acreage Dedication Plat
3. Development Plan, which includes the following information:
 - a. Plat showing existing road to the Cawley A No. 1 well, and planned access road, outlined in red, leading due north to Elizonda-Federal "A" No. 1.
 - b. Plat showing location layout, including position of the rig, mud tanks, reserve pit, pipe racks, etc.
 - c. Blow out preventer diagram showing arrangement of BOP stack and components.
 - d. Schematic diagram showing hook up of BOP's, choke manifold and mud/gas separator.
 - e. Schematic diagram of casing program.
 - f. Summary of mud program.

The Elizondo-Federal "A" No. 1 is a north offset to the Cities Service Oil Company Cawley A No. 1 that was recently completed as a wildcat discovery in the Morrow zone.

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
