In reference to your letter of February 20, 1976 concerning the discrepancy of vented gas on Form C-105 and the pipeline connection on Form C-104, we submit the following explanation as requested,

Although El Paso Natural Gas Company actually had a pipeline connection on the above referenced well, the line pressure was approximately 800 psi as opposed to the well pressure of 25 psi. Therefore, the pressure of El Paso's line was too great to allow gas from the well to enter.
