Cities Service Oil Company respectfully requests permission to drill the No. 1 Simpson A, located 1980' FNL and 810' FEL, Section 29-21S-27E, Eddy County, New Mexico.

In support of this application, the following data is submitted:

1. Form C-101, Application for Permit to Drill.
2. Form C-102, Well Location and Acreage Dedication Plat.
3. Development plan which includes the following information:
 - a. General plat of area showing location in relation to the City of Carlsbad, nearby gas wells and the existing and proposed road system.
 - b. Location layout plat showing approximate amount of land required for the drilling pad, mud tanks, reserve pit, etc.
 - c. Blow out preventer diagram showing arrangement of BOP stack and components.
 - d. Schematic diagram showing hook up of BOP's, choke manifold and mud/gas separator.
 - e. Schematic diagram of proposed casing program.
 - f. Summary of mud program.
