Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.

Item 4: If there are no applicable State requirements, locations on Federal or Indian land should be described in accordance with Federal requirements. Consult local State or Federal office for specific instructions.

Total Depth of 9505' reached at 8:15 AM, 4-23-74. Ran Comp. Neutron, Formation Density and Dual Laterolog Logs. Ran 9278' of 5½" casing set at 9292' and cemented in three stages with 1200 sacks. 1st stage- 500 sacks at 9292'; 2nd stage- 200 sacks with DV tool at 6186'; 3rd stage- 500 sacks with DV tool at 4688'. Plug down on 3rd stage at 12:17 PM 4-28-74. Ran temperature survey and found top of cement on outside of 5½" casing at 2100'.

Drilled out DV tool and cleaned out to a plug back TD of 9259' on 5-13-74. Completion attempts made at following intervals with either non-commercial or 100% water bearing production tests.

9166-9176 (Morrow) Zone plugged as per verbal instructions from USGS by setting CI bridge plug at 8760', then four sacks cement via dump boiler on top of bridge plug (5-20-74).

8335-8341 (Strawn) Zone plugged as per verbal instructions from USGS as follows: 25 sacks 8450-8225; 25 sacks 6300-6075 (5-28-74).

5767-5770 (Wolfcamp) Zone) These zones plugged as per verbal approval
5677-5680 (Wolfcamp) Zone) by USGS with CI bridge plug set at 5630'
5656-5664 (Wolfcamp) Zone) and capped with 4 sx cement on top of
bridge plug (6-12-74).

3758-3766 (Abo) Zone This zone and subsequent plugs will be set in accordance with verbal instruction from Mr. Jim Kanauff with the USGS on 6-17-74 as follows: 100' plug 3758-3766
100' plug 2150-2050 or across stub of 5½" casing
100' plug 1892-1792 across 9 5/8" intermediate casing shoe
20' plug at surface with permanent marker installed.

Notification will be given when well site is cleaned and leveled and is ready for inspection.
