This well has been plugged back to the Strawn (perfs: 11,403' - 11,601'). Testing indicates well will produce 495 MCF/D, 10 BC/D and 700 BW/D @ a tubing pressure of 725#. Sales line pressure averaged approximately 700#.

There are no SWD facilities in this area, however we are considering the possibility of re-entering BEU No. 61 (a D&A location 4200' NNW of this well) and making a SWD well out of it.

This well will be kept safe. Request that we be allowed to leave well "temporarily shut in".

Instructions
