It is proposed to spud a 17-1/2" hole on or before May 31, 1974 with cable tools and to drill ahead with cable tools until the rotary tools contracted for this well are available to move in, rig up, and continue the drilling operations.

The anticipated delay in the availability of rotary tools is less than 10 days. This delay is the result of complications in the operations of the well currently being drilled by the contracted rig.
