Gentlemen:

Champlin has received a notice that the subject report is delinquent (copy attached). On October 11, 1977 Champlin submitted Forms C-103, C-105 and a letter requesting exemption from the test (copies attached). Although the well's performance has improved since the writing of the letter, the well is still not performing normally. During the week ending November 4, 1977 the well averaged 332 MCF gas per day and 8 BWPD. A chlorides check on November 1, 1977 indicated the water was still "load". The well has improved to the point that it unloads the water daily and no longer has to be blown to the atmosphere weekly.

By letter dated 28 October, 1977, Champlin requested an exception to OCC Rule 112-A-6-C for the well until the well stabilizes. For the reasons stated in the previous correspondence, Champlin respectfully requests that the State "36" Well No. 1 Morrow also be exempted from the shut-in pressure survey.
