

Development plan for surface use to accompany, "Applications to Drill Onshore Oil, Gas, or Geothermal Steam Wells on Public Domain and acquired Federal Lands:"

1. Existing roads. Location is 2086' east of County Road No. 239.
(See attached topo and land plat.)
2. Planned access roads. 2086' from county road to location.
3. Location of well. See attached land plat.
4. Lateral roads to wells locations. See attached land and topo
plats.)
5. Location of tank batteries and flowlines. Tank battery on edge of pad.
Flow lines from well to tanks and pileline.
6. Locations and types of water supply.
Haul from nearest commercial source.
7. Methods for handling waste disposal. pits
8. Location of camps. None planned
9. Location of airstrips. None planned
10. Location layout to include position of the rig, mud tanks, reserve
pits, burn pits, pipe racks, etc. See sketch.
11. Plans for restoration of the surface. In accordance with the
regulations.
12. Any other information which the Approving Official considers
essential to his assessment of the impact on the environment.
It is difficult to imagine how anything we could do could hurt the
environment at this location.
