Gentlemen:

The subject well was drilled and subsequently plugged and abandoned by Texas International Petroleum Corporation on September 17, 1974 after testing the Morrow formation at a total depth of 12,590'.

Pennzoil Company plans to re-enter this well and make a completion attempt in the Atoka zone at a total depth of 11,500'. Attached are copies of the U.S.G.S. Forms 9-330 and 9-331 that were submitted by Texas International which shows the casing and cement plugs in the well at the current time.

Pennzoil Company respectfully requests Administrative Approval to set 2 7/8" tubing for production casing and submit following data in support of this request:

- 1. The Atoka zone does not produce corrosive liquid to the best of our knowledge.
- 2. The maximum bottom hole pressure expected will not exceed the working pressure of the 2 7/8" tubing (X-line) that will be cemented at approximately 11,900'.
- 3. The well will be a single completion.
- 4. There is no known Atoka production within one mile of the proposed re-entry location.
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
