Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your letter of December 17, 1974, wherein you request approval for the tubingless completion of your Penn Federal Well No. 1 located 1980 feet from the North and West lines of Section 31, Township 20 South, Range 30 East, Eddy County, New Mexico.

It is our understanding that you propose to re-enter this old P & A well and complete it in the Atoka zone of the Pennsylvanian at a total depth of 11,900 feet. Further, that the production casing would be composed of 2 7/8-inch tubing set at total depth and cemented back to approximately 9,700 feet. There is presently a string of 13 3/8-inch surface casing at 451 feet, cement circulated, and 8 5/8-inch intermediate casing at 4,066 feet, cement circulated.

Inasmuch as no known corrosive or pressure problems exist in this area that would render this type of completion impracticable, and otherwise make the same inadvisable, Pennzoil Company is hereby authorized to complete the well as described above.

The Commission does reserve the right to rescind this approval if subsequent developments indicate that waste is occurring or that reservoir damage is resulting because of the tubingless completion.
