Dear Leon:

Pennzoil Company again respectfully requests a permit to re-enter the subject well which was originally drilled and subsequently plugged and abandoned by Texas International Petroleum Corporation on September 17, 1974. A permit was granted for this re-entry on 12-23-74, but the work was not done.

In support of this request, the following data is submitted:

1. Form 9-331C
2. Location plat (NMOCC C-102 revision)
3. Small scale map of existing roads with ~~proposed~~ *present* access road and well location. *will be disturbed by this action.*

In addition, please be advised of the following:

1. Mud pits will be steel.
2. No composite or airstrip is proposed.
3. Tank battery will be located near or adjacent to corner of location pad. (If needed)
4. Water supply to be either trucked in or secured from rancher in vicinity.
5. Land surface will be restored to as near original condition as possible and to satisfaction of U.S.G.S., following the cessation of all drilling and completion operations.
6. All detrimental waste will be disposed of observing all good disposal practices.
7. A mud program is attached.
8. A diagram of the proposed blow-out preventer hook-up is attached.
