Pennzoil Company again respectfully requests a permit to re-enter the subject well which was originally drilled and subsequently plugged and abandoned by Texas International Petroleum Corporation on September 17, 1974. A permit was granted for this re-entry on 12-23-74, but the work was not done.

- Mud pits will be steel. 1.

- 4. Water supply to be either trucked in or secured from rancher in vicinity.
- Land surface will be restored to as near original 5. condition as possible and to satisfaction of U.S.G.S., following the cessation of all drilling and completion operations.
- 6. All detrimental waste will be disposed of observing all good disposal practices.
- 7. A mud program is attached.
