Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your letter wherein you have requested approval to meter the wet stream production from each zone, Avalon-Morrow and undesignated Atoka, in your dually completed BQ 2 Federal Well No. 1, then to commingle said production into a single separator, thence through one dehydration unit and on through the sales meter.

It is our understanding that the liquid production would be allocated to each zone on the basis of separate zone tests taken every three months. Further, that there is no diversity of ownership between the two zones.

Written approval is hereby given to your proposal, which we had previously advised you verbally would be acceptable. As stated before, however, this approval may be rescinded in the event either of both zones in this well become subject to gas prorationing.
