Application for Permit to Drill:

1. We will exit off paved road running from LaHuerta to U.S. Highway 82 to the northwest. Attached is Exhibit #1 on which Section 6 is outlined in red.
2. Planned access roads - location is adjacent to existing road.
3. Location of existing wells - exhibit #1 & #2 shows existing wells.
4. Lateral roads to well location - these roads are shown on both Exhibits #1 & #2.
5. Location of tank battery - tank battery will be located on southwest corner of drilling pad.
6. Location and type of water supply - fresh water will be trucked. The brine water will be trucked from potash mine.
7. Methods for handling waste disposal - all solid waste from the drilling operation will be buried.
8. Location of camp - no camp intended.
9. Location of airstrip - no airstrip intended.
10. Location of layout to include position of the rig, mud tanks, reserve pits, burning pits, pipe rack, etc. Rig will have engines facing south and "V" door and racks to the east shown in plat #3.
11. Plans for restoration of the surface - the pits will be filled and leveled. All area not used will be restored to as near the original condition as possible.
