On June 26, 1975, an Application for Permit to Drill was approved by Mr. William A. Gressett, District Supervisor of Oil Conservation Commission District II office, for the above-captioned well.

The application was accompanied by a copy of a letter notifying the City of Carlsbad of the drilling of the well and a postal receipt for certified mail indicating the letter had been mailed on June 26, 1975. This letter was addressed to Mr. Claude Tabor, City Administrator.

Mrs. Grace has now complied with the provisions of Oil Conservation Commission Rule 102(b) and any remaining problems concerning the drilling of this well will have to be resolved between Mrs. Grace and the City of Carlsbad.
