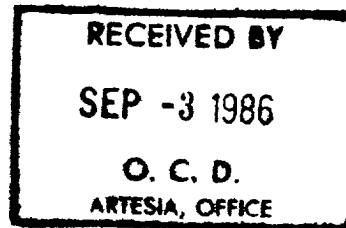

Gentlemen:

Communitization Agreement SW-1043 was approved October 17, 1975 effective as of September 1, 1975. This agreement communitized the S $\frac{1}{2}$  sec. 12, T. 21 S., R. 26 E., NMPM, 301.00 acres of Federal land in leases NM-3607, NM-3606, NM-A-15461 and 19.00 acres of Fee land, as to dry gas and associated liquid hydrocarbons producible from the Morrow formation. The term of the agreement is for two years and so long thereafter communitized substances are or can be produced from the communitized area in paying quantities.

Our records show that the well dedicated to the above-described communitized spacing unit, your Inexco Federal No. 1 located on Lease NM-3607, in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. 12 was completed in the Morrow formation 11,004 - 11,249 feet on October 27, 1975. Production from this well ceased during November 1983.

Accordingly, in the absence of a well capable of producing communitized substances in paying quantities, Communitization Agreement SW-1043 is considered to have expired by its own terms as of November 31, 1983, the last day of the month in which the well on the communitized spacing unit ceased to produce.

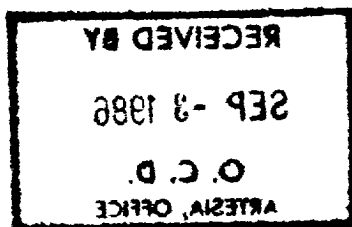
