

SURFACE USE PLAN

1. EXISTING ROADS - Area map, Exhibit "A", is a reproduction of the U.S.G.S., NE/4 Bandanna Point, New Mexico 15' Quadrangle. Existing and proposed roads are shown on the exhibit. All roads shall be maintained in a condition equal to that which existed prior to the start of construction.
 - A. Exhibit "A" shows the proposed development well site as staked.
 - B. From Carlsbad, New Mexico, travel north 13 miles on U.S. Highway 285. Turn west on blacktop and go west-southwest 12 miles. Turn east on caliche road and follow to well site (approximately 5 miles).
2. PLANNED ACCESS ROADS - Approximately 2500± linear feet of restored road will be improved.
 - A. The access road will be crowned and ditched to a 12'-00" wide travel surface with a 40' right-of-way.
 - B. Gradient on all roads will be less than 5.00%.
 - C. No turnouts will be necessary.
 - D. If needed, road will be surfaced with a minimum of 4" of caliche. This material will be obtained from a local source.
 - E. Restored road way is still visible. Earth work will be as required by field conditions.
3. LOCATION OF EXISTING WELLS IN A ONE-MILE RADIUS.
 - A. Water wells - Rancher water well located approximately 1/2 mile northeast of location.
 - B. Disposal wells - None known.
 - C. Drilling wells - None known.
 - D. Producing wells - As shown on Exhibit "C"
