Dear Mr. Gressett:

In response to your letter requesting additional information on the referenced well, and our expected timing for completion of testing, please be advised that we are currently preparing to run a four-point test on the well.

The well has been flowing very erratically since completion and we have been attempting to determine whether or not the well will sustain a commercial flow rate. We are now producing about 80 BWP, 26 BCPD and 440 MCFD on a 14/64" choke with 500 pounds flowing tubing pressure. After testing on several chokes, it appears that the well will flow at this rate and keep the water unloaded.

We have not as yet signed a contract to sell the gas but are negotiating with several purchasers.

We should four-point the well on Friday and leave it shut in until we get a connection. Therefore, we will not need any additional testing allowable other than the 1,000 barrels recently requested.

We appreciate your consideration of our request for the additional testing allowable and trust that this adequately answers your questions.

Enclosed for your information are copies of our electric logs run on the referenced well.
