Cities Service Oil Company respectfully requests permission to drill the No. 1 C.D.M. "A" located 660' FWL, 990' FNL, Sec. 29-21S-27E, Eddy County, New Mexico.

In support of this application, the following data is submitted:

1. Form C-101, Application for Permit to Drill.
2. Form C-102, Well Location and Acreage Dedication Plat.
3. County road map showing location of proposed drilling site in relation to surrounding area.
4. Plat showing approximate dimensions of location layout including position of the rig, mud pits, reserve pits, etc.
5. Blowout preventer diagram showing arrangement and components of BOP stack.
6. Schematic diagram showing hook-up of BOP's, choke manifold and mud/gas separator.
7. Schematic diagram of casing program and estimated formation tops.
8. Summary of mud program.

Directions to the C.D.M. "A" No. 1 are as follows:

In the northeast part of the City of Carlsbad, go north on Burgandy Ave. and cross the bridge over the Carlsbad Irrigation District's EAST CANAL. Turn to the left and follow the EAST CANAL right-of-way approximately 3/8 of a mile.

The location is off to the right about 100' and is marked with a red and white flag on a lath.
