Morrow, Unit K, Sec. 36-20S-27E

Yates Petroleum Corporation seeks administrative approval of a tubingless completion in an Undesignated Morrow field as provided for under OCC Rule 107 (C). Subject well is the MWJ State "GW" No. 1 well located 1980 FSL, 1980 FWL of Section 36-T20S-R27E, Burton Flats area, Eddy County, New Mexico.

A 4½" production casing was run in this well during the Xmas holidays and later found to be erroneously set at 10300' instead of 11300'. A liner is necessary for completion, and in order to assure a good cement program, it will be necessary to centralize the liner. It is proposed to run 11300' of 2 7/8" non-upset tubing and cement into the 4½" casing. After abandonment of the Morrow pay, the 2 7/8" tubing will be cut-off and re-completions will be in the 4½" casing.
