NWJ State GW Well No. 1  
K-36-20S-27E, Eddy County

Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your letter dated January 6, 1977, requesting approval for the tubingless completion of the above-captioned well.

It is our understanding that this well is completed with 13 3/8-inch casing at 500 feet cemented with 200 sacks, 8 5/8-inch casing at 2400 feet cemented with 1300 sacks, 4 1/2-inch casing at 10,300 feet (sacks unknown), and 2 7/8-inch casing at 11,300 feet cemented back into the 4 1/2-inch. The 2 7/8 would be perforated to produce from the Morrow.

The above completion is hereby approved with the understanding that upon depletion of the Morrow, the 2 7/8-inch casing will be cut and pulled and the well recompleted in a higher pay through the 4 1/2-inch casing. At that time a standard tubing shall be run or a tubing exception obtained from the Commission.
