On December 8, 1976, Cities Service Oil Company submitted an Application for Permit to Drill our Government AD No. 2 located 2310' FNL and 660' FWL of Section 27-21S-27E, Eddy County, New Mexico. The application was approved January 11, 1977.

Our planned access road was described and shown on plats in the application.

Since then, we have had to reroute our access road because one of the Fee land owners did not want the road on her land. To clarify the situation, I am attaching a plat of the immediate area showing existing lease roads in black, the former route of the proposed access road in dashed red and the current proposed access road in solid red.

The new route of the access road has been staked and flagged. We have again engaged the services of the "Agency of Conservation Archeology" in Portales, New Mexico to survey this new section of proposed access road. Their findings will be reported to you.

Mr. Jim Parr, Realty Specialist with the Bureau of Land Management in Roswell, New Mexico, has given me the following information concerning surface and minerals' ownership:

All of Section 27-21S-27E is Federal surface and Federal minerals.

The NE/4 of Section 28-21S-27E is Federal surface and Federal minerals.

The E/2 of the NW/4 of Section 28-21S-27E is private surface and Federal minerals.
