ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

BY THE COMMISSION:

This cause came on for hearing at 9 a.m. on December 15, 1976, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before Examiner Richard L. Stamets.

NOW, on this 4th day of January, 1977, the Commission, a quorum being present, having considered the testimony, the record, and the recommendations of the Examiner, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS:

(1) That due public notice having been given as required by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.

(2) That the applicant, Read & Stevens, Inc., seeks approval of an unorthodox gas well location for its W. R. State Com. Well No. 1 to be drilled 660 feet from the South line and 990 feet from the East line of Section 6, Township 21 South, Range 27 East, NMPL, to test the Pennsylvanian formation, Burton Flat Field, Eddy County, New Mexico.

(3) That Lots 9, 10, 15, and 16, and the SE/4 of said Section 6 is to be dedicated to the well.

(4) That a well at said unorthodox location will better enable applicant to produce the gas underlying the proration unit.

(5) That no offset operator objected to the proposed unorthodox location.
