THE APPLICATION OF WESTERN OIL PRODUCERS, INC.  
FOR A DUAL COMPLETION.

ORDER NO. MC-2367

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER  
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Rule 112-A Western Oil Producers, Inc., made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission on June 29, 1977, for permission to dually complete its Hunker Com Well No. 1 located in Unit K of Section 35, Township 21 South, Range 27 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit production of gas from the Wolfcamp formation adjacent to the East Carlsbad-Wolfcamp Gas Pool and from the East Carlsbad-Morrow Gas Pool.

Now, on this 1st day of July, 1977, the Secretary-Director finds:

- (1) That application has been duly filed under the provisions of Rule 112-A of the Commission's Rules and Regulations;
- (2) That satisfactory information has been provided that all operators of offset acreage have been duly notified; and
- (3) That waivers of objection have been received from such offsetting operators.
- (4) That the proposed dual completion will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
- (5) That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion are feasible and consonant with good conservation practices.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant herein, Western Oil Producers, Inc., be and the same is hereby authorized to dually complete its Hunker Com Well No. 1 located in Unit K of Section 35, Township 21 South, Range 27 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit production of gas from the Wolfcamp formation adjacent to the East Carlsbad-Wolfcamp Gas Pool and from the East Carlsbad-Morrow Gas Pool through the casing-tubing annulus and the tubing respectively.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Rule 112-A.

PROVIDED FURTHER, That applicant shall take packer-leakage tests upon completion and annually thereafter during the Shut-in Pressure test period for the East Carlsbad-Morrow Gas Pool.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That jurisdiction of this cause is hereby retained for the entry of such further orders as the Commission may deem necessary.
