

THE APPLICATION OF WESTERN OIL  
PRODUCERS, INC. FOR A DUAL  
COMPLETION.

ORDER NO. MC-2367  
AMENDED

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER  
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION DIVISION

Under the provisions of Rule 112-A Western Oil Producers, Inc., made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division on April 21, 1978, for permission to dually complete its Hunker Com Well No. 1 located in Unit K of Section 35, Township 21 South, Range 27 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit production of gas from the East Carlsbad-Wolfcamp Gas Pool and from the East Carlsbad-Morrow Gas Pool.

Now, on this 15th day of May, 1978, the Division Director finds:

(1) That application has been duly filed under the provisions of Rule 112-A of the Division Rules and Regulations;

(2) That satisfactory information has been provided that all operators of offset acreage have been duly notified; and

(3) That waivers of objection have been received from such offsetting operators.

(4) That the proposed dual completion will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.

(5) That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion are feasible and consonant with good conservation practices.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant herein, Western Oil Producers, Inc., be and the same is hereby authorized to dually complete its Hunker Com Well No. 1 located in Unit K of Section 35, Township 21 South, Range 27 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit production of gas from the East Carlsbad-Wolfcamp Gas Pool and from the East Carlsbad-Morrow Gas Pool through the tubing and the casing-tubing annulus respectively.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Rule 112-A.

PROVIDED FURTHER, That applicant shall take packer-leakage tests upon completion and annually thereafter during the Shut-in Pressure test period for the East Carlsbad-Morrow Gas Pool.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That jurisdiction of this cause is hereby retained for the entry of such further orders as the Division may deem necessary.
