Gentlemen:

The subject well is currently producing at a rate of 20 MCFPD with a flowing tubing pressure of 540 psi. In order to evaluate the possibility of producing gas with the assistance of a compressor, we propose to test the well by flaring gas to the atmosphere.

It is felt that three days of testing will allow ample time to determine the most efficient gas producing rate.

Therefore, we request permission to flare approximately 200 MCF in this 72 hour period. This test can be scheduled within two weeks after notification of approval.
