

Re: Application for Permit to Drill Cities Service Oil Company's Little Box Canyon Unit No. 3 located 1980' FEL, 660' FNL, Section 7-21S-22E, Eddy County, New Mexico

II. Multi-Point Surface Use and Operation Plan.

The Little Box Canyon Unit No. 3 has been staked. The work area and access road has been staked and flagged. The Agency of Conservation Archeology in Portales, New Mexico has been hired to make an archeological survey of the work area and access road. Their findings concerning cultural resources will be reported to the Bureau of Land Management in Roswell, New Mexico.

1. Existing Roads.

A portion of an Eddy County highway map is attached which shows the proposed location in relation to the City of Carlsbad and the existing road system leading into the area. The existing road system is high-lighted in yellow.

Directions to location:

Start at Carlsbad. Take Highway 285 toward Artesia 10 miles and turn left at Conoco Station on top of hill.

Go 9.2 miles to Y and take right fork.

Go 4.4 miles to Marathon plant on south side of road.

Go past Marathon plant 5.7 miles and take the right fork onto a caliche road (there is a Great Western and El Paso sign at this point).

Continue in a westerly direction 6.7 miles passing the following landmarks:

2.5 miles to water tank on north side of road (take the road bearing to the right).

2.9 miles to Burro Hill.

1.3 miles to turn off to north.
6.7 miles

Go north on caliche lease road 3.0 miles. The planned new access road will originate at this point.

2. Planned Access Road.

A. The planned access road is staked and flagged. It is indicated in red on the Eddy County highway map and also in red on an attached USGS quadrangle map. The road will be 12' wide and 3/4 mile long and will enter the drilling pad at the southeast corner.
