Gentlemen:

Your Notice of Intention to convert and operate as a salt water disposal well, the No. 56-Big Eddy Unit in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of sec. 35, T. 21 S., R. 28 E., N.M.P.M., Eddy County, New Mexico on oil and gas lease LC-067144, by injecting produced waters into the Delaware formation from approximately 3310 feet to 3375 feet, is hereby approved subject to the following:

1. If off-lease waters are to be included in this disposal system, appropriate approval to operate this well as such must be secured from the Bureau of Land Management prior to disposing of any such waters.
2. Where applicable and required, right-of-way permits for pipelines from other leases must be secured from the Bureau of Land Management prior to laying of any such gathering lines.
3. Completion Report and Log (form 9-330 in quintuplicate) must be filed with this office after completion of this well.
4. The usual Sundry Notice (form 9-331 in quintuplicate) must be filed with this office prior to commencing any further workover, treatment, suspension of operation, or change of status of this well.
5. A monthly injection report, which includes injected water for that month, cumulative injected water, and average injection pressures, must be submitted to this office in duplicate.

We propose to:

Set CIBP @ 3450'. Dump 10' Hydromite on top of plug.
Perforate with 2 JSPT @ 3310'-3330' and 3350'-3375'.
Acidize perforations with 3000 gals 7 1/2% HCl acid.
Run internally plastic coated tubing with tension packer to 3250'.
Displace annulus with water containing corrosion inhibitor. Set packer.
Install pressure gauge on tubing and on annulus.
Place on injection.

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.

Item 4: If there are no applicable State requirements, locations on Federal or Indian land should be described in accordance with Federal requirements. Consult local State or Federal office for specific instructions.
