We respectfully request permission to plug the above well because evaluation of logs and DST showed to be a noncommercial well. Spotting of cement plugs using class "H" neat cement as follows:

Plug #1	5550' - 5400'	150' w/65 sx
Plug #2	4150 - 4050'	100' w/ 40 sx
Plug #3	3250 - 3150'	100' w/50 sx
Plug #4	1600 - 1500'	100' w/35 sx
Plug #5	0' - 20'	20' w/19 sx

A 10 foot piece of 4" pipe with a cap on top will be placed in the surface plug. Being 6 feet below ground level and 4 feet above ground level, the 4 foot piece clearly identifying the well. The plugging operation has been completed pursuant to the instructions given by Your Mr. Jim Knauf on October 27, 1977 while the drilling rig was on the hole. The reserve pits and cellar have been fenced and are presently drying. Upon received approval the location will be leveled and cleaned of any unnecessary items and any other specifications required by the BLM.

CONDITIONS OF APPROVAL, IF ANY:

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations.
