While performing the test, we will take all possible safety precautions. The gas will be burned, and there will be at least two people on location at all times during the test. One of the people on location will be a consultant who specializes in safety equipment for working with gas containing hydrogen sulfide. We will have their safety equipment on location; this includes breathing equipment, warning signs, wind socks, electronic hydrogen sulfide monitoring and alarm systems, and a flare stack with igniter.

The attached topographic map shows the location of the well. There are four residences approximately 3/4 mile north of the well, and U. S. Highway 62-180 is about 1 mile northwest. The well will be flowed only when the wind is blowing such that it will direct gas away from the residences and the highway. We have contacted the people living there and have obtained their names and telephone numbers. Warning signs will be posted at approaches to the area.
