Texaco Exploration and Production Inc. respectfully requests a one year extension of the Temporarily Abandonment Status of the above well. TA status was approved 12-30-92 based upon the results of a casing integrity test conducted on 12/1/92 and witnessed by BLM representative Don Early (A copy of the 12/1/92 test chart is on the reverse side of this form). TEPI requests TA status on this well through 12/1/95.

Justification: TEPI believes that some unexplored Delaware potential exists in this area. Unfortunately, due to the location of the subject lease, the Federal 34 #1 would be uneconomical for TEPI to operate. As a result, TEPI is exploring opportunities to sell the subject lease. A one year TA status extension would give TEPI adequate time to seek a potential buyer.


