10-27-94 - Moved in and rigged up pulling unit.  
10-28-94 - Cut bolts off of wellhead. Packer stuck. Worked loose. Would not go down hole. POOH and hung up in BOP. Worked loose. WBIH with on/off tool and latched onto RBP. POOH. Shut in.  
10-29-94 - Rigged up wireline. Perforated 6171-6301' w/44 .42" holes as follows: 6171, 74, 76, 79 & 6181' (10 holes); 6213, 17, 21, 23, 29, 32, 34, 38 & 6242' (18 holes) and 6273, 75, 78, 84, 86, 93, 97 & 6301' (16 holes). WIH w/RBP and packer. Tested packer to 3000#. Straddled perforations 6273-6301' and acidized with 1500 gallons 15% NEFE acid and ball sealers. Communicated up. Moved and set packer above all new perforations, 6171-6301'. Acidized with 3000 gallons 15% NEFE acid and ball sealers. Swabbed.  
10-30-31-94 - Swabbing.  
11-1-94 - Swabbed. Shut well in. Engineers evaluating.
