2. Planned Access Roads:

Map showing all necessary access roads to be constructed or reconstructed, showing:

See Map "B" (attached)

- (1) Width 12'
- (2) Maximum grades 3/1
- (3) Turnouts Every 1/2 mile
- (4) Drainage Design: No special drainage design required, access road follows topography
- (5) Location and size of culverts and brief description of any major cuts and fills.

There will be one low water crossing approximately 1 mile on the Ranch Trail.

- (6) Surfacing material - Caliche
- (7) Necessary gates, cattle guards, or fence cuts:

Two Cattle Guards required

- (8) (New or reconstructed roads are to be center-line flagged at time of location staking)
