10. Plans for Restoration of Surface

Pits will be backfilled and leveled as soon as practical to original condition. Commencement of rehabilitation operations will immediately follow removal of drilling and completion equipment from location and rehabilitation of the surface is planned to be completed within 45 days from commencement.

11. Other Information

- A. Terrain: Gently sloping.
- B. Soil: Rocky
- C. Vegetation: Sparse mesquite
- D. Surface Use: Grazing
- E. Ponds and Streams: Pecos River approximately 0.75 miles east of location.
- F. Water Wells: Levers Federal No. 1 approximately 0.5 miles south of location.
- G. Residences and Buildings: Conoco station 0.8 miles southwest of location. See attached Exhibits "A" and "B".
- H. Arroyos, Canyons, Etc.: A small, water-cut arroyo is 100' distant. See attached Exhibit "B" - topographic map of the area.
- I. Well Sign: Sign identifying and locating well will be maintained at drill site with the spudding of the well.
- J. Open Pits: All pits containing mud or other liquids will be fenced.
