On March 16, 1979 in Order No. R-5943 the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission ordered that all mineral interests of the Pennsylvanian formation underlying all of Section 24, T-21-S, R-23-E, Eddy County, New Mexico are pooled to form a standard 640 acre gas spacing and proration unit to be dedicated to the well Cotton proposes to drill at a point 660 feet from the south line and 660 feet from the east line of Section 24.
