ORDER OF THE DIVISION

BY THE DIVISION:

This cause came on for hearing at 9 a.m. on December 7, 1978, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before Examiner Richard L. Stamets.

NOW, on this 16th day of January, 1979, the Division Director, having considered the testimony, the record, and the recommendations of the Examiner, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS:

(1) That due public notice having been given as required by law, the Division has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.

(2) That the applicant, Texas Oil & Gas Corporation, seeks approval of an unorthodox gas well location for its State Com Well No. 1 to be located 660 feet from the South line and 660 feet from the West line of Section 18, Township 21 South, Range 26 East, NMPM, to test the Wolfcamp and Pennsylvanian formations, Catclaw Draw-Morrow Gas Pool, Eddy County, New Mexico.

(3) That all of said Section 18 is to be dedicated to the well.

(4) That a well at said unorthodox location will better enable applicant to produce the gas underlying the proration unit.

(5) That certain offset operators objected to the proposed unorthodox location.

(2) That all of said Section 18 shall be dedicated to the above-described well.

(1) That an unorthodox gas well location for the Wolfcamp and Pennsylvanian formations is hereby approved for the Texas Oil & Gas Corporation State Com Well No. 1 to Range 26 East, NPM, Catclaw Draw-Morrown Gas Pool, Eddy County, New Mexico.

located at a point 660 feet from the South Line and 660 feet from the West Line of Section 18, Township 21 South, be located at a point 660 feet from the South Line and 660 feet from the West Line of Section 18, Township 21 South, the Texas Oil & Gas Corporation State Com Well No. 1 to the Wolfcamp and Pennsylvanian formations is hereby approved for the Texas Oil & Gas Corporation State Com Well No. 1 to Range 26 East, NPM, Catclaw Draw-Morrown Gas Pool, Eddy County, New Mexico.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

(11) That such limitation of the subject application with the assigned number of the acreage factor set out in Finding No. 640 acres.

(11) That such limitation should be based upon the presumed maximum number of productive acres within the target horizon in said Section 18 compared to the number of acres in a standard production unit best be acreage factor of 0.35 (224 acres divided by 640 acres).

(10) That to offset the advantage gained over the proposed unorthodox location should be limited at the protesting offset operator, production from the well at the Morrown formation.

(9) That the standard production unit in the Catclaw Draw-Morrown Gas Pool is 640 acres.

(8) That the evidence presented demonstrates that no more than 224 acres of said Section 18 may be presumed to be productive of gas from the target horizon.

(7) That said channel sand is being produced from at least one other well in the Catclaw Draw-Morrown Gas Pool.

(6) That said State Com Well No. 1 is being projected to a sole target horizon being a middle Morrown channel sand.
