## 10. PLANS FOR RESTORATION OF THE SURFACE continued

- B. Any unguarded pits containing fluids will be fenced until they are filled.
- C. After abandonment, any special rehabilitation and/or special revegetation requirements of the surface management agency will be complied with and accomplished as expeditiously as possible.

## 11. OTHER INFORMATION:

- A, <u>Topography</u>: Land surface is hilly with the general slope from south to north.
- B. <u>Soil</u>: The top soil in the area is a rocky, sandy loam.
- C. Flora and Fauna: The vegetative cover is generally sparse and consists of scrub cedar, weeds and range grasses. Wildlife in the area is that typical of semi-arid desert land and includes coyotes, rabbits, rodents, reptiles, dove and quail.
- D. <u>Ponds and Streams</u>: There are no rivers, streams, lakes or ponds in the area.
- E, <u>Residences and Other Structures</u>: The nearest occupied dwelling, a ranch house, is approximately 1-1/2 miles southeast. The nearest windmill is 1/2 mile north.
- F. ARCHAEOLOGICAL, HISTORICAL, AND CULTURAL SITES: None observed in the area.
- G. Land Use: Grazing and hunting in season.
- H. Surface Ownership: Federal
