MULTI-POINT SURFACE USE AND OPERATIONS PLAN

Cities Service Company Well No. 2 Government "S" 660' FSL and 1980' FEL, Section 3-205-28E Eddy County, New Mexico Lease NM-9818

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This plan is submitted with the Application for Permit to Drill the above described well. The purpose of the plan is to identify the location of the proposed well, the proposed construction activities and operations plan, the magnitude of necessary surface disturbance involved and the procedures to be followed in rehabilitating the surface after completion of the operation so that a complete appraisal may be made of the environmental effects associated with the operation.

The well has been staked by a Registered New Mexico Land Surveyor and the work area and access road has been staked and flagged. Dr. J. Loring Haskell has been engaged to make an Archaeological Reconnaissance of the work area and access road. His findings concerning cultural resources will be reported to the Bureau of Land Management.

1. Existing Poads

A portion of an Eddy County highway map is attached showing the location of the well as staked. The existing road system and the well site are shown in relation to the City of Carlsbad, New Mexico.

To further identify the location, the well is spotted on a copy of a USGS "Oil City, New Mexico" Quadrangle map that is also attached.

Directions to Location:

Start at the intersection of Green and Canal streets in Carlsbad. Follow highway 62-180 toward Hobbs in a northeasterly direction 8-1/2 miles.

Turn north on black topped county road. Follow black topped road north six (6) miles.

Turn west on black topped county road. Go in a westerly direction two (2) miles to Cities Service Company's No. 1 Government "R".

Turn northeasterly on caliched county road. Go two (2) miles northeast to intersection with a caliched lease road going west.
