

of catclaw, grease wood, weeds and range grasses. Wildlife in the area is that typical of semi-arid desert land and includes coyotes, rabbits, rodents, reptiles, dove and quail.

- D. Ponds and Streams: The Pecos River and Lake Avalon are approximately 1-1/2 miles west of the well site.
- E. Residences and Other Structures: There are no occupied dwellings or other structures within 1-1/2 miles of the well site.
- F. Archaeological, Historical, and Other Cultural Sites: None observed in the area.
- G. Land Use: Grazing, recreation and hunting in season.
- H. Surface Ownership: Federal.


