Marathon Oil Company plans to permanently abandon the Upper Penn zone and recomplete this well in the Wolfcamp zone. A 5-1/2" CIBP will be set @ 6895' w/10 sx Class C neat cement on top of it. The well will then be perforated @ 6006'-6013', 6022'-6042', & 6042'-6062' @ 4 jsf. A 10,000 gal. 17% HCL acid frac will be performed injecting @ 8-10 BPM. Anticipated Max pressure is 2800 psi for 2-7/8". Tubing will be set @ 6000'.
