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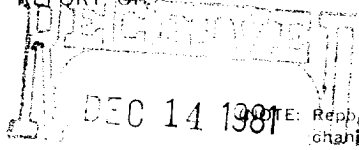

Drilled 11" hole to 4618'. Ran 40 jts 8-5/8" 32# K-55 ST&C and 67 jts 28# S-80 ST&C with DV tool at 2639'. Cemented 1st stage with 700 sxs Lite tailed with 150 sxs Class "C" plus additives. Open DV tool and pumped 1800sxs Lite tailed with 100 sxs Class "C" + additives. Plug down at 12:30 PM CST 11/17/81.

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.
