HNG OIL COMPANY's proposed location will be situated on the southfacing shoulder of an outlier of Quahada Ridge. In general, this landform is overlain by consolidated aeolian deposits of Holocene and Pleistocene age. Presently, the coeval surface is being downcut by a system of ephemeral water courses with runoff ultimately tributary to Old Indian Draw. Pedons belong to the Typic Torripsamment subgroup and host caliche inclusions in erosional areas.

## Floristics

Areal soil individuals host a mixed overstory of Prosopis juliflora, Acacia greggii, Quercus havardii, Yucca glauca, and Atriplex canescens. Most commonly occurring forbs are Senecio sp., Euphorbia sp., Monarda punctata, Croton sp., Dithyrea sp., Hymenoxys sp., Gillia sp., Phyllanthus sp., and Krameria sp.. The Gramineae is represented by Aristida sp., Muhlenbergia porteri, and Setaria macrostachys.

## Cultural Resources

During the course of this reconnaissance, one archaeological site, NMAS 5138, was recorded.
