- D. Ponds and Streams: There are no rivers, streams, lakes or ponds in the area.
- E. Residences and other structures: None. There are no water wells in the area.
- F. Archaeological, Historical and Cultural Sites: A small archaeological area was discovered 600' south of the drill pad on the proposed access road. The area has been flagged with a pink surveyor's ribbon as shown on Exhibit "B" and the proposed access road shifted 100 feet to the west so as to avoid the site.
- G. Land Use: Grazing and hunting in season.
- H. Surface Ownership: Federally owned.


