Gentlemen:

In the vicinity of Lake Avalon, the Pecos River Water Authority is requesting that all drill sites be at or above an elevation of 3194' above sea level - the crest of Lake Avalon Dam.

The amended location of 2430' FNL and 2530' FEL of Section 2, T-21-S, R-26-E is at an elevation of 3192.6', but it is also the highest and only site available in Lot 26 as determined by an on-the-ground survey with John W. West's crews.

Acreage in Lots 27, 28, 29, 30, 35, 36, 37 and 38 is assigned to El Paso Federal No. 2, located in Lot 29. Acreage dedicated to El Paso Federal No. 6 consists of Lots 25, 26, 31, 32, 33, 34, 39 and 40 and the remaining acreage in Section 2, Lots 17 through 24, is being preserved for the possibility of an El Paso Federal No. 7.

It is respectfully requested that you approve the application to drill at this amended location although the elevation is 1.4 feet less than required by the Pecos River Water Authority.
