1. EXISTING ROADS:

- A. Exhibit "A" is a road map showing the location of the proposed well as staked. Point "A" on the plat is US 62-180, at Milepost 43.8, approximately 8 miles northeast of Carlsbad, New Mexico. To go to the proposed well site from this point, exit US 62-180 and go north 5.6 miles to a point where a caliche road goes east. Turn east and go 2.0 miles to a point where a caliche road goes north. Turn north and go 0.4 mile. The proposed location is 600 feet east of this point. To go to the proposed location from Point "B" on the plat, which is at Milepost 49.5, go north 2.0 miles, then west 2.9 miles, and then north 0.4 mile.
- B. Exhibit "B" is a plat showing existing roads in the vicinity of the proposed well site. Existing roads are color coded.
- C. Any repair to existing roads does not appear necessary at the present time.

2. PLANNED ACCESS ROAD:

- A. Length and Width: The new road will be 15 feet wide and approximately 650 feet long. The proposed new road is labeled and color coded red on Exhibit "B". The center line of the proposed new road has been staked and flagged.
- B. Surfacing Material: Caliche. Watered, compacted and graded.
- C. Maximum Grade: Two percent.
- D. Turnouts: None necessary.
- E. Drainage Design: New road will be crowned with drainage to both sides.
- F. <u>Culverts</u>: None required.
- G. Cuts and Fills: None required.
- H. Gates and Cattle Guards: None required. No fences involved.
