Dear Mr. Thames:

As requested in your letter dated January 13, 1988 I am forwarding pertinent pages out of gas proration schedules for S.E. New Mexico for months June, 1987 through January, 1988. Each of these schedules except June shows your Lea Federal Well No. 1 to be excessively overproduced in violation of our rules. Our computer automatically generates a letter advising the producer and transporter of such violation the first month such violation occurs, which would have been in July, 1987. When I asked our data processing manager for the file copy he said it would take some time to retrieve that far in the past. It is our position, however, that the gas proration schedule is the official notice of violation.

If you need further data, our records are open to the public and can be copied at a nominal cost. I made these copies myself, but my time is limited. I have also enclosed a copy of Order R-8170 which is our basic gas proration order.

I hope this material is of some assistance to you.
