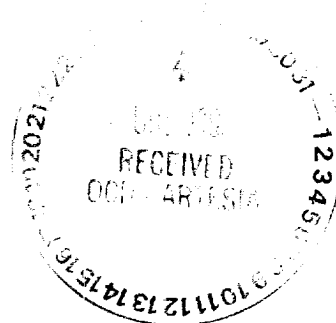

Dear Mr. Duncan:

Reference is made to your written request dated October 9, 1998, and subsequent phone conversations with myself on October 26, 1998, whereby you requested an extension to the injectivity test to be conducted on the Avalon Delaware Unit Well No. 916. It is our understanding that the injectivity test commenced on October 9, 1998, and that you are now requesting authorization to inject into the well a maximum of 30 days over a six week period. You are hereby authorized to extend the test parameters for the subject well as follows:

- a) Actual injection into the well shall be limited to 30-days; and,
- b) The duration of the test period shall extend until November 24, 1998.

All other provisions contained within the previous authorization shall remain in full force and effect.
