THE APPLICATION OF EXXON COMPANY, U.S.A.

**ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION DIVISION**

Under the provisions of Rule 701(B), Exxon Company, U.S.A. made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division on April 1, 1991, for permission to complete for salt water its Yates Federal "C" Well No. 35 located in Unit A of Section 5, Township 21 South, Range 27 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico.

THE DIVISION DIRECTOR FINDS THAT:

- (1) The application has been duly filed under the provisions of Rule 701(B) of the Division Rules and Regulations.
- (2) Satisfactory information has been provided that all offset operators and surface owners have been duly notified; and
- (3) The applicant has presented satisfactory evidence that all requirements prescribed in Rule 701 will be met.
- (4) No objections have been received within the waiting period prescribed by said rule.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

- (1) The applicant herein, Exxon Company, U.S.A. is hereby authorized to complete its Yates Federal "C" Well No. 35 located in Unit A of Section 5, Township 21 South, Range 27 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit the injection of salt water for disposal purposes into the Delaware formation at approximately 2702 feet to approximately 3100 feet through 2 7/8-inch plastic lined tubing set in a packer located at approximately 2650 feet.
