IN ORDER TO AVOID HAVING PART OF THE ACCESS ROAD TO THIS PROPOSED WELL SITE IN THE NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$  OF SECTION 19, AS INITIALLY PROPOSED, WE NOW PLAN TO CHANGE THE NORTH-SOUTH SEGMENT OF THE ACCESS ROAD TO GO NORTH FROM SPENCER STREET ON THE WEST SIDE OF THE FENCE RATHER THAN ON THE EAST SIDE. THE PROPOSED ACCESS ROAD WOULD THEN BE AS SHOWN ON THE ATTACHED, REVISED EXHIBIT "B", AND WOULD GO NORTH FROM SPENCER STREET ALONG THE EAST SIDE OF THE NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$  OF SECTION 19 AND INTO THE SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$  TO INTERSECT THE NORTHWEST TRENDING SEGMENT OF THE ACCESS ROAD, WHICH IS NOT CHANGED.

THE NORTHWEST TRENDING SEGMENT OF THE ACCESS ROAD WAS ARCHAEOLOGICALLY EXAMINED AND A REPORT FURNISHED IN THE ORIGINAL ARCHAEOLOGICAL REPORT. ARRANGEMENTS HAVE BEEN MADE FOR ARCHAEOLOGICAL EXAMINATION OF THE PROPOSED NEW NORTH-SOUTH SEGMENT AND A REPORT WILL BE FURNISHED.

ALSO ATTACHED IS LETTER CONCERNING OPERATOR-LAND OWNER AGREEMENT.

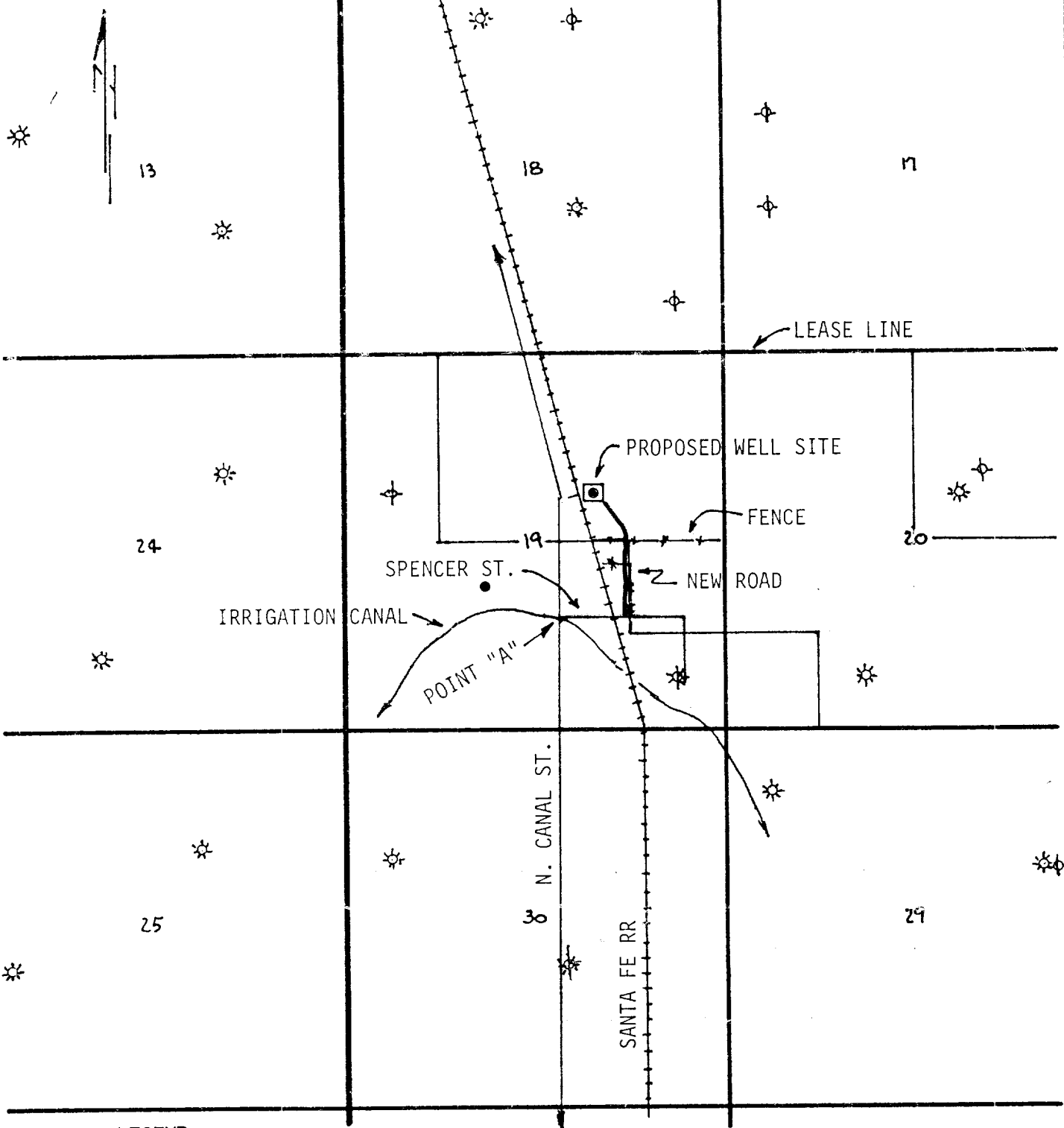

Gentlemen:

This is to advise that TXO Production Corp. has contacted Thomas D. Parker and J. Bond Westaway, the surface owners under the well site and a portion of the access road, and Ernest O. Jowers, also a surface owner under a portion of the access road, concerning entry and surface restoration after completion of drilling operations at well No. 1 Pioneer Federal Com, located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 19, T.21 S., R.27 E., Eddy County, New Mexico, lease NM-0354232.

Work to be done after completion of drilling operations is as follows:

If the well is completed for production, the well location will be cleaned up and the drilling pits will be filled as soon as they are dry.

If the well is plugged and abandoned, all pits will be filled and levelled, the location will be cleaned up, and the well pad and access road will be left in place.
