2. Pit will be lined with plastic.
3. Tanks will be emptied down to lowest possible level by vacuum truck, tank bottoms will then be manually transferred to temporary pit.
4. Temporary pit will be vacuumed dry within 48 hours after it is filled.
5. Tank bottoms from pit will be taken to CRI reclamation facility.
6. Backfill and cover pit.
